## **“GURU DRONACHARYA AWARD” CONFERRED UPON PROF. H.L. TRIVEDI**

One more feather was added into the cap of Dr. H. L. Trivedi when he was honored with “Guru Dronacharya Award” on 28<sup>th</sup> May, 2017. The honor was conferred upon him jointly by Avatar Foundation and Mumbai Nephrology Group for his life time contributions to the field of Nephrology in the country. Avatar foundation was established in 2012 with an aim to train young and practicing renal physicians in rare, challenging and newer upcoming techniques in the field of interventional Nephrology. “Guru Dronacharya Award” was established in a humble attempt to honor the invaluable contribution of those teachers who have shaped the face of Nephrology specialty in the country. It represents a symbol of recognition and gratitude on behalf of the innumerable students who are now flag bearers of nephrology and are practicing what they have learnt from these stalwarts. Selection committee of the award selected Dr. H.L. Trivedi from Ahmedabad and his contemporary Dr. M.K. Mani from Chennai as recipients of this award for the year 2017 and presented the award at their respective places because of their inability to travel due to age. The award was given away at the hands

of Dr. D.S. Rana, Chairman, Avatar foundation and Dr. Hemant Mehta, treasurer of Mumbai Nephrology Group on Sunday afternoon in the basement auditorium of the Institute. The function was attended by staff members of the Institute and past students of Dr. H.L. Trivedi which was followed by high tea. On this occasion, a movie named “Rag-Vairag” based on life story of Dr. H.L. Trivedi was also announced.

## **HISTORY CREATED – 17 KIDNEY AND 9 LIVER TRANSPLANT IN 11 DAYS**

A history was created by the Institute when we performed 17 kidney transplants and 9 liver transplants from 9 deceased donors between 30<sup>th</sup> May to 10<sup>th</sup> June 2017. Out of these, 5 donors were from Surat, 3 were from Bhavnagar and 1 was from Rajkot. This is the first record in the history of Institute and Gujarat State that in a short duration of 11 days, we have done 26 transplants. Previously in the year 2009, the Institute has done 8 kidney transplants and 2 liver transplants

from 4 brain dead cadaver donors in a span of 48 hrs. This herculean task was possible due to untiring services of all the doctors, technical staff, nursing staff and class IV personell. Our organ retrieval team has travelled about 5000 km by road to procure the organs and has worked continuously keeping family life aside. The Institute congratulates all the staff members for accomplishing this task and also those doctors and counsellors who have convinced and motivated the family members to donate organs of their beloved ones, without them this task would not have been possible.

#### **INSTITUTE OF TRANSPLANTATION SCIENCES FOUNDATION DAY CELEBRATED AS A 'PRATYAROPAN GAURAV UTSAV'**

The historical milestone was created by the Institute when we crossed the figure of 5000 kidney transplants and 225 liver transplants in the month of June. To mark this glorious achievement, we organized "Pratyaropan Gaurav Utsav" on 19th June, 2017 as a part of celebration of foundation day of Institute of Transplantation Sciences.

The journey of kidney transplant started from 1979 and liver transplant from 2008 at IKDRC-ITS and this is the highest number of transplants in the public sector Institute in the country. On this occasion, we felicitated adult patients who have completed 20 years after kidney transplant, 5 years after liver transplant and children who have completed 15 years after kidney transplant. Total 34 patients were felicitated, out of which 16 were kidney recipients, 14 were liver recipients, 3 were combined kidney and liver recipients and 1 was combined kidney and pancreas recipient. They were honored with a shawl, certificate and symbol of "Om" at the hands of Hon'ble Minister of Health and Family Welfare Shree Shankar Chaudhary, the chief guest of the function. The event was made memorable by the presence of Mr. Dharendra Suthar who was transplanted in 1986 and nine patients who were children when transplanted but now are adults having their own family and living normal life. Hon'ble Minister congratulated the entire team for this glorious achievement and promised to complete the new premises of the Institute in Manjushree Mill Compound by the end of this year. He also announced that Government will bear 50% expenses of air-lift of organs from other cities of Gujarat.

#### **DECEASED DONOR ORGAN TRANSPLANTATION**

**Smt. Pragnaben Jaychandbhai Patel** was a 66 years old housewife from Gir. Her husband died 11 years ago. She was staying with two daughters and a son. On 29th March, 2017 when she got up to go to bathroom, she started getting giddiness and fell down. Her family shifted him immediately to Dr. Suchak Hospital, where C.T. Scan and M.R.I. Brain was done which showed multiple hemorrhages of the brain. She was later shifted at Sir Takhtasinhji General Hospital, Bhavnagar for better care under the treatment of Dr. Rajendra Kabariya where she was declared brain dead. Dr. Rajendra Kabariya convinced her family for organ donation. Pragnaben's daughter-in-law Janviben is a radiologist and her brother Praveenbhai is working for 108 emergency service, so they were aware about the organ donations and consented for the same. Her both kidneys were given to 28 year's old Shri Parimal Chaganbhai Viramgama from Amreli. Liver was donated to 61 year's old Hareshbhai Kirtanbhai Parikh from Ahmedabad. These transplants were performed on 4th April, 2017 and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Ravibhai Thakarshibhai Devani** was a 22 years old boy, basically from Surat, and was working in an Insurance company as a Marketing executive at Ahmedabad. On 6th April, 2017 at the noon time, he went for lunch on his bike, met with an accident trying to save a cow and fell unconscious on the road. He was immediately shifted to Hope Neuro care Hospital for emergency treatment, and later shifted at Unity Hospital, Surat for better treatment by his family members. Neuro Physician Dr. Bhadresh Mangukiya and Neuro Surgeon Dr. Vihang Sali declared him brain dead. In this situation his

parents agreed for organ donation. His one kidney and pancreas was given to 36 years old Shri Mitesh Ambubhai Chauhan from Vadodara who was suffering from diabetic kidney failure since long. The other kidney was given to 18 years old Ronak Mahaveer Chechani from Rajasthan. Both the patients are doing well. Liver was donated to 31 years old Umangbhai Bimalbhai Patel from Surat, but unfortunately he succumbed to fungal infection 3 months after transplant. These transplants were performed on **10th April, 2017**.

**Shri Jayeshbhai Manubhai Parmar** was a 46 years old man, basically from Vadodara and doing a job in Gulf country. He used to visit his family once in two months. On 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2017 at 11 A.M. he went on his bike for some work with his father and on the national highway, their bike was hit by speeding car. Both of them fell down on the road. Co-incidentally one private Ambulance was passing by which shifted them to nearest Shreeji Hospital of Vadodara. They were admitted under treatment of Dr. Rupesh Shah. Jayeshbhai soon passed into comatose state and was declared brain dead. Dr. Rupesh Shah convinced the family members for organ donation. Jayeshbhai's brother Harshadbhai knew about organ donation and gave permission for the same. His one kidney was given to 28 years old Shri Kushal R. Shah from Ahmedabad while other kidney was given to 25 years old Shri Prakash Hasanand Jaysindhani. Liver was donated to 55 year's old Shri Kamleshbhai Kantilal Thakkar from Ahmedabad. These transplants were performed on **18<sup>th</sup> April, 2017** and all the patients are doing well.

**Smt. Madhuben Jagjivanbhai Limbadiya** was a 60 years old housewife from Botad. On 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2017, she was hit by a speeding bike

near her home. She fell down on the road with head injury and was unconscious. She was immediately shifted to a private hospital of Botad and was later shifted to Sir Takhtasinhji General Hospital, Bhavnagar for further treatment. M.R.I. brain was done there and Neuro Surgeon Dr. Rajendra Kabariya declared her brain dead. Dr. Kabariya convinced her family members for organ donation. Her one kidney was given to 72 years old Shri Ramchandra Kishorilal Sharma basically from Punjab but since many years stayed in USA, while other kidney was given to 54 years old Shri Krishnaben Karansingh Sharma from Bhavnagar. Ramchandrabhai is doing well now, but Krishnaben did not survive. Liver was donated to 65 year's old Smt. Chandanben Sureshbhai Kotel from Rajkot, and she is doing well now. These transplants were performed on **25<sup>th</sup> April, 2017**.

**Shri Dharmikbhai Arvindbhai Mardiya** was a 22 years old brilliant M.Sc. student from Rajkot having a two sisters. He met with an accident when he was returning home along with his father. Both of them fell down on the road. Nearby people shifted them to private hospital of Jetpur, but due to their serious condition, they were shifted at Wockhardt Hospital under the treatment of Dr. Kant Jogani. Dr. Kant Jogani declared Dharmikbhai brain dead. At that same time his father Arvindbhai was also undergoing the treatment, and after hearing about his son, he was shocked. In such difficult moments, relatives convinced him for organ donation for saving the life of organ failure patients. His one kidney was given to 15 years old Shri Rudransh Contractor, while other kidney was given to 40 years old Shri Bhaveshbhai B. Bhalala, both from Ahmedabad. Liver was donated to

65 year's old Shri Pannalal Chhaganbhai Patel from Vadodara. These transplants were performed on **9<sup>th</sup> May, 2017** and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Vijaybhai Jerambhai Solanki** was a 52 years old man from Bhavnagar doing a job in a private company and stayed with his family. On 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 at the morning time of 11.30 A.M he went for job on his bike, and immediately met with an accident trying to save a cow and fell down unconscious on the road. He was shifted to Government Hospital of Talaja in 108 Ambulance by nearby people. Later he was shifted to Sir Takhtasinhji General Hospital, Bhavnagar under the treatment of Dr. Rajendra Kabariya, where M.R.I. brain was done and he was declared brain dead. His son convinced other family members for organ donation and they also agreed for the same. His one kidney was given to 28 years old Shri Asrar Ahmad from Rajasthan, while other kidney was given to 21 years old Shri Vijesh Rajpara from Bhavnagar. Liver was donated to 38 year's old Shri Bipinbhai Vrajlal Ghatliya from Rajkot. These transplants were performed on **14<sup>th</sup> May, 2017** and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Shubham Shaileshkumar Patel** was a 19 years old resident of Ahmedabad and only son of his parents. His father, while doing various labour jobs, gave him education till B.Sc. On 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 midnight, he went to Bhavnagar with his friends on bike to learn about event management and met with an accident. Shubham was severely injured and was immediately shifted to Medicare Hospital for emergency treatment where his condition deteriorated continuously. He was later shifted to Voks Hospital and finally to Lion's Hospital, Mehsana for further treatment by his family members

where he was declared brain dead. His family was aware about the Organ donation and they gave permission for the same. Dr. Rakesh Patva from Lion's hospital played a pivotal role in coordinating things. His one kidney was given to 17 years old Shri Sonam Khuslani from Ahmedabad, while other kidney was given to 21 years old Shri Gaurav V. Lakhiyar from Jamnagar. Liver was donated to 56 year's old Shri Kokilaben Haribhai Patel from Gandhinagar. These transplants were performed on 21<sup>st</sup> May, 2017 and all the patients are doing well.

**Smt. Bharatiben Navinchandra Pandya** was a 69 years old lady from Ahmedabad suffering from high blood pressure for past 10 years, for which she took medications. On 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 while doing some house work, she started getting giddiness and fell down unconscious. Her husband immediately shifted her to H.C.G. Hospital for emergency treatment. She was diagnosed to have brain hemorrhage for which she was operated. But after the aggressive treatment for 3 days, she was declared brain dead. Her son was aware about the organ donations and he convinced his father for the same. Due to high blood pressure related problems, her kidneys were not useful but her liver was in good condition. Her liver was donated to 44 years old Daxaben Janakkumar Brahmhatt from Ahmedabad on 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2017. However, she did not survive and died on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 due to infection related problems.

**Smt. Gauriben Muljibhai Sakariya** was a 45 years old housewife basically from Botad. On 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 she started getting giddiness, severe vomiting and immediately became unconscious. Her family shifted her to nearest hospital of Dr. Pujara. Considering her serious condition, she was

shifted to Sir Takhtasinhji General Hospital, Bhavnagar under the treatment of Dr. Rajendra Kabariya. The C. T. Scan of the brain was done which showed multiple hemorrhages and eventually after intensive treatment for four days, she was declared brain dead. Dr. Kabariya convinced her family for organ donation. Her one kidney was given to 32 years old Shri Bhumini R. Shah from Ahmedabad, while other kidney was given to 53 years old Shri Kiritbhai Patel from Vadodara. These transplants were performed on 30<sup>th</sup> May, 2017, but unfortunately Bhumini did not survive. Bhumini suffered from intestinal obstruction and was operated for the same. He was an active member of "Kidney Theater Group" so we have lost one artist from this group.

**Smt. Samjuben Bhecharbhai Vithlani** was an 85 years old resident of Bhavnagar having 4 sons and 5 daughters, with lot of grandsons/daughters in family. On 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 afternoon she became unconscious suddenly and fell down. She was immediately shifted by her family to Jivandeep Hospital for emergency treatment but due to her serious condition, she was later shifted Sir Takhtasinhji General Hospital, Bhavnagar under care of Dr. Rajendra Kabariya. M.R.I. Brain showed multiple hemorrhages of brain and she was declared brain dead. Her family doctor Dr. Bharatbhai Mangukiya and Dr. Kabariya convinced her family members for organ donation. Her son Babubhai and other family members agreed for the same. Her one kidney was given to 50 years old Shri Dulabhai Chhaganbhai Vadodariya from Surat, while other kidney was given to 59 years old Smt. Bharatiben Patel from Sabarkantha. Liver was donated to 57 year's old Shri Ranabhai Bhayabhai Zinzala from Surat. These

transplants were performed on 02<sup>nd</sup> June, 2017 and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Navnitbhai Babubhai Chaudhari** was 30 years old man basically from Mangrol having a wife with two children and a drama actor by profession. On the evening of 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2017 he went from home on bike and while crossing railway lines, his bike slipped and he fell down on the road unconscious with a grievous injury to head. Nearby people on the road shifted him to nearest Referral hospital for emergency treatment. But due to his serious condition, he was later shifted to Civil Hospital, Surat, where M.R.I. brain was done which showed multiple hemorrhage of brain. The doctors declared him brain dead and convinced his father for organ donations. He also agreed setting an example in his community. His one kidney was given to 14 years old Shri Tilak Hitesh Shah from Ahmedabad, while other kidney was given to 31 years old Shri Punit Zalan from Surat. Liver was donated to 48 year's old Shri Valabhai Devabhai Rathod from Morbi. These transplants were performed on 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2017 and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Piyushbhai Rasikbhai Parekh** was an 80 years old man staying in Bhavnagar. He was always a sports enthusiastic and in his young age he was a Ranji Trophy player. He was a well-known figure in the society being an honorable trustee in many jewellery associations, temples and hospitals. On 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2017 he was busy in his routine activities, and after taking dinner, was sitting on bed watching television. Suddenly he was not feeling well. His son was away in Bhutan with his wife. His wife immediately called Nephew Dr. Jayesh Gandhi who shifted him to H.C.G. Hospital for emergency treatment. Neuro Physician

Dr. Dabhi advised C. T. Scan of brain which showed multiple hemorrhage of brain. Neuro Surgeon Dr. Rajendra Kabariya came there, checked his condition and declared him brain dead. Piyushbhai's son, Jatan came back with his wife from Bhutan, and took the decision with his mother to donate the organs. His one kidney was given to 65 years old Shri Galyabhai Damor from Ahmedabad, while other kidney was given to 52 years old Smt. Manjulaben Chauhan from Ahmedabad. Galyabhai is doing well now, but Manjulaben unfortunately did not survive. Liver was donated to 42 year's old Shri Navneetbhai Babulal Jobanputra from Bhavnagar, and he is doing well. These transplants were performed on 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2017.

**Smt. Sidhhama Sailu Gadudas** was a 58 years old woman basically from Telangana but staying in Surat and working in weaving department. On 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 early morning she complained about headache to her son, and started feeling giddy. Soon she fell down and became unconscious. Her son immediately shifted her to Smimer Hospital for emergency treatment and later shifted her to Global Hospital for further treatment. M.R.I. of brain was done which showed a blood clot in her brain and she was declared brain dead. She had two sons who decided to donate her organs. Her both kidneys were given to 62 year's old Shri Haresh Shalunke from Ahmedabad, who is doing well. Liver was donated 45 years old Parashbhai Chinubhai Jani from Ahmedabad, but he did not survive. These transplants were performed on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2017.

**Shri Sukhabhai Narottambhai Rathod** was a 55 years old farmer staying in Mandroi Village. He had gone to Pavagadh with his family for pilgrimage. While climbing the steps

at Pavagadh, he slipped and had a head injury. He became unconscious and was immediately shifted to nearest private hospital for emergency treatment and later shifted to Civil Hospital, Surat for further treatment where he was declared brain dead. His family gave permission for donating organs. Coincidentally Dr. Pranjal Modi and his team was at Surat at the same time for another organ harvesting, so they immediately rushed to Civil Hospital, Surat. His one kidney was given to 32 years old Shri Jay Krishna Pandya from Vadodara, while other kidney was given to 22 years old Jinalbhai D. Patel from Valsad. Liver was donated to 52 years old Bakulbhai Nilambhai Vaishnav from Rajkot. These transplants were performed on 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, and all the patients are doing well.

**Smt. Gomtiben Harjibhai Italiya** was a 70 years old from Surat enjoying a retired life with family. On 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 she slipped from ladder and had head injury. Immediately she became unconscious. Family members shifted her to Asakta-Ashram Hospital for emergency treatment but due to massive bleeding, her brain suffered severe damage. Neuro Surgeon Dr. Hashmukh Sojitra and Neuro Physician Dr. Bhadresh Mangukiya declared her brain dead. She had three sons Mansukhbhai, Kanjibhai and Jaysukhbhai. All of them agreed for donation of the organs. Her one kidney was given to 51 years old Shri Maheshbhai Vadgama from Morbi, while other kidney was given to 50 years old Shri Shailendra Kumar from Jharkhand. Liver was donated to 53 years old Sureshbhai Parsottambhai Krishnani from Valsad. These transplants were performed on 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Ravibhai Govindbhai Solanki** was a 28 years old man from

Rajkot doing a furniture related business with his father. On 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 he was found in an unconscious state from a pan parlor with head injury. His family shifted him to Madhuram Hospital for emergency treatment. But due to his serious condition, he was later shifted to Wockhardt Hospital for better treatment where Neuro Surgeon Dr. Kant Jogani declared him brain dead. Dr. Jogani and Dr. DivyeshViroja convinced his family for organ donations, and they also agreed for the same. His one kidney was given to 33 years old Shri Priteshbhai Patel from Surat, while other kidney was given to 45 years old Shri Shilpa Parekh from Ahmedabad, and both are doing well. Liver was donated 50 years old Vijaybhai Hemandas Thakkar from Vadodara, but he did not survive. These transplants were performed on 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2017.

**Shri Rajendra Maliram Verma** was a 34 years old man basically from Rajasthan but staying at Surat for his job. On 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 early morning when he was doing a marble flooring work, he slipped and fell down with an injury to his head. He was immediately shifted to Sardar Smarak Hospital and later shifted to Mahavir Trauma Hospital for better treatment. M.R.I. Brain was done which showed large cerebral hemorrhage and he was declared brain dead. His family came at Hospital from Rajasthan immediately. Doctors explained the condition to family members and also convinced them for organ donation. His one kidney was given to 14 years old Shri Sejiben from Junagath, while other kidney was given to 43 years old Shri Jayantibhai Patel from Ahmedabad. Liver was donated to 48 years old Devendrabhai Santilal Patel from Chhota Udaipur. These transplants were performed on 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2017,

and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Yogeshbhai Mohanbhai Patel** was a 42 years man from Surat and doing bike repairing work. On 13<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 at 3 P.M. he started getting headache, giddiness and severe vomiting. Soon he fell down and became unconscious. He was immediately shifted to Parijat Hospital for emergency treatment where C. T. Scan brain was done which showed a brain tumor. His family shifted him at Adventis Hospital for better treatment where he was operated for removal of brain tumor. However, surgery was unsuccessful and eventually he was declared brain dead. In this critical situation his wife Ranjanben decided to donate the organs. His one kidney was given to 10 years old Shri Vachan Vora from Surat, while other kidney was given to 40 years old Shri Rajesh Thakkar from Jamnagar. Liver was donated to 58 years old Rameshbhai Revabhai Patel from Mehsana. These transplants were performed on 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, and all the patients are doing well.

**Shri Sanju Sukhlal Patil** was a 48 years old man from Surat working in a weaving department and was having wife, one daughter and two sons in the family. On 20<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 while crossing a road, he was hit by a speeding autorickshaw. He fell down on the road with head injury and was unconscious. Nearby people on the road called 108 ambulance and immediately shifted him to Civil Hospital, Surat where M.R.I. brain was done which showed multiple hemorrhages of the brain. He was eventually declared brain dead. Sanjubhai's brothers and wife decided to donate his organs. His one kidney was given to 55 years old Shri Shishir Bhaskarbhai Bhatt from Surat, and he is doing well now. While other kidney was given to 27 years old Shri Rajeshwari

**Vinodkumar Raval** from Surendranagar, but due to some technical reasons his kidney was later removed. Liver was donated after splitting them in 2 parts. One part of liver was given to 7 years old Neha Bharatbhai Parmar from Mehsana, and other part was given to 13 years old Zebalstiyad Ahmad Morisvala. These transplants were performed on 22<sup>nd</sup> June, 2017. While Zeba is doing well, unfortunately Neha died after a month due to infection after surgery. **Shri Mehulbhai Ashokbhai Vather** was a 19 years old boy from Patan who stayed with his mother. On 22<sup>nd</sup>, June 2017 he went to attend a relative's marriage at 9.30 A.M. While going there, his bike slipped, he had a head injury and became unconscious. Nearby people on the road shifted him to nearest Krishna Hospital for emergency treatment. But later he was shifted to Sims Hospital for better treatment where he was declared brain dead. In this critical situation his mother and uncle decided to donate his organs. His one kidney was given to 38 years old Shri Dipaben Modi from Ahmedabad, while other kidney was given to 48 years old Shri Shaileshbhai Satishbhai Joshi from Rajasthan. Liver was donated to 43 years old Kartik Devprasad Thakkar from Vadodara. These transplants were performed on 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2017, and all the patients are doing well.
